SPACE COAST OPEN TOURNAMENT RULES

1. ELIGIBILITY: Open to all members of the USBC Adult membership and be 18 years of age or older at time of competition and show proof of current membership. Entrants must show current USBC membership card or must pay current USBC dues for an unattached membership prior to bowling.

PBA / PWBA MEMBERS: Not more than 1 professional member may bowl on any 4-member team, and not more than 1 professional member may bowl on a doubles team.

Senior Events (**OPTIONAL**) for bowlers age 50 and over. Entrants must have reached their 50th birthday by October 28, 2023.

2. TOURNAMENT FORMAT: Tournament will consist of a Team Event (4 person), Doubles Event (2 person) and Singles Event.

3. ENTERING AVERAGE:

a.) Entrants will use the highest 2022-2023 fall average of 21 or more games.

b.) If "a" does not apply, the bowler will use the highest 2023 summer average of 21 games.

c.) If neither a nor b apply the bowler will use their highest current average as of October 27, 2023, of 21 games or more.

d.) If none of the above apply the bowler will bowl scratch.

USBC Rule 319a "10 Pin Rule" is waived.

USBC Rule 319e "AVERAGE ADJUSTMENT FOR ENTRY" will apply.

4. HANDICAP: Handicap will be 90% of the difference between the bowlers entering average and 240. Handicap will be applied on an individual basis on each three - game series.

5. ENTRY FEE: Entry fee is \$35.00 per Bowler, per event. Lineage & expenses are \$20.00 and Prize fund is \$15.00 for Team, Doubles and Singles Events

6. OPTIONAL EVENTS:

Optional Events are available at \$10.00 for each event per person. Team Scratch; Doubles Scratch; Singles Scratch.

All Events Handicap are All Events Scratch are \$5.00 for each event per person.

Scratch Team, Scratch Doubles & Scratch Singles events can ONLY be entered if the participant is entered in the handicap event.

Prize fund returned 100%.

Optional SENIOR SINGLES (\$10.00) & SENIOR ALL EVENTS (T&D&S) Handicap and Scratch are \$5.00 each. Bowlers must bowl the Handicap events to be considered for the optional Senior Category and not violate Rule 1. Bowlers may choose to enter both, one or neither of the All Events. Prize fund returned 100%.

7. Walk-Ins: Will NOT BE ACCEPTED.

8. REFUND: After entries have been received, and the dates assigned by Tournament Director have been accepted, no fees shall be refunded. Total entry fee must be included with entry form.

9. PRIZE REPORTING: USBC Rule 319d "REPORTING PRIOR PRIZE WINNINGS" will apply.

10. REPLACEMENTS: Substitutes will be allowed. Substitutes will bowl in the position of the absent bowler as submitted on the application provided the entrant does not violate Rule #1. Entering Rule #3 applies.

11. BOWLERS RESPONSIBILITY: Bowlers are responsible for verifying their own average, whether submitted by the bowler, the team captain, or others. If the submitted average is lower than required and results in more handicap, the bowlers score will be disqualified. If the submitted average is higher than required, prize winnings will be based on the submitted average.

12. TARDY BOWLERS: Bowlers who miss one or more frames by not being present and ready to bowl when it is their turn, shall be credited with zero (0) pins for those frames missed.

13. PRIZE DISTRIBUTION: Prize money will be distributed at a ratio of at least one for every five (1:5) entries and ALL EVENTS will be 1:10. Scratch payout will be distributed at a ratio of at least one for every five (1:5) entries. Optional Senior Events follow same payout. Tournament prizes will not be awarded until all averages are verified.

14. The Team Captain is responsible for notifying all entrants of dates and times they are scheduled to bowl and must check in all team members at least 30 minutes (30) prior to squad time.

15. Errors in scoring must be reported, in writing, within 24 hours to the Tournament Director. Any protest or appeal affecting the playing rules or eligibility must be confirmed in writing to a tournament or local association official, or the United States Bowling Congress BEFORE the tournament prizes are awarded.

16. The Tournament Director reserves the right to re-rate or reject any entry prior to bowling for just cause.

17. DRESS CODE: Appropriate attire is required. THERE WILL BE NO TANK TOPS SHIRTS or SHORT SHORTS.

18. Any rules not covered above shall be governed by USBC Rules.
